Expulsion of members

- 13 (1) Where the committee is of the opinion that a member of the association:
(b) has persistently and willfully acted in a manner prejudicial to the interests of the station, the committee may, by resolution.
(c) expel the member from the association or
(d) suspend the member from membership of the association for a specified period.

(3) Where the committee passes a resolution under clause (1) the secretary shall, as soon as practicable, cause a notice in writing to be served on the member.

In accordance with the constitution, you may address the committee not earlier than 14 days and not later than 28 days after service of this notice

(d) at the meeting you may attend and speak, or submit to the committee at or prior to the date of that meeting written representations relating to the resolution.

With that in mind, we have set a date of 17th October 2011 at 4.00pm
